A non-refundable fee of \$50.00 (check or cash) will be charged for each set of Contract Documents. Checks will be made payable to the Union County Engineer

A Pre-Bid meeting will be conducted in the office of the Board of Commissioners of Union County on Wednesday, February 17, 2010 at 10:00am at the office of the Board of Commissioners.

Funding for this contract has been provided in part through the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), and is subject to the reporting and operational requirements of ARRA.

This notice can be obtained through the County Engineer's website by typing www.union.oh.us/engineer under the "Current Bid Information" section.

Proposals must be received by 11:00 A.M. local time, on Thursday, March 4, 2010, in the office of the Board of Commissioners of Union County located in the County Office Building, 233 W. Sixth Street, Marysville, Ohio 43040. The proposals will be opened and read aloud at 11:30 A.M. on the same date.

Each bidder is required to furnish with its proposal, a Bid Guaranty and Contract Bond in accordance with Section 153.54 of the Ohio Revised Code. Bid security furnished in Bond form, shall be issued by a Surety Company or Corporation licensed in the State of Ohio to provide said surety.

Each proposal must contain the full name of the party or parties submitting the proposal and all persons interested therein. Each bidder must submit evidence of its experiences on projects of similar size and complexity. The owner intends and requires that this project be completed no later than November 30, 2010.

Disadvantaged Business (DBE) Requirement. DBE participation goals (subcontracts, materials, and supplies) have been set on this project for those certified as DBE's in accordance with Title 49 CFR, Part 26, and qualified to bid with ODOT under Chapter 5525 of the Ohio Revised Code (O.R.C) The Contractor must ensure that the DBE subcontractor(s) is performing a "commercially useful function" as defined in CFR 26.55.

DBE Goal: 4%

The engineer's estimate is \$1,504,000.

This project falls under the federal requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act for prevailing wages.

Only pre-qualified bidders are eligible to submit bids for this PROJECT. Pre-qualification status must be in force at the time of bid, at the time of award, and through the life of the construction contract.

Contractor compliance with the equal employment opportunity requirements of Ohio Administrative Code Chapter 123, the Governor's Executive Order of 1972, and the Governor's Executive Order 84-9 shall be required.

The Board of Commissioners of Union County reserves the right to reject any or all bids, or to increase or decrease or omit any item or items, or to waive any informalities in any bid(s), and to award the contract to the lowest and best bidder in accordance with Section 307.86 of the Ohio Revised Code as determined by the Board of Commissioners of Union County.
